2656 was included within a consent calendar with other bills in the Senate, so the vote on the whole was counted. Legislators could have moved to consider the bill separately. 7323SubAaa-A20SubAaa was voted on in the Senate as an amendment to remove the budget article, in contrast to the House, which voted on the articles of the budget individually. To simplify the data, therefore, we reversed the signs of the actual votes, because a "yea" vote on the amendment to remove the article was effectively a "nay" vote to the article. 7209SubAaa was the House version of the redistricting bill, and the representatives chose to vote on the different sections separately. Under the thinking that an objection to one section was an admission that the process was problematic, we only credited "nay" votes to representatives who so voted on all
